2nd KEYNOTE: Christopher Lawrence “Bong” Go, a native of Davao City, was appointed by President Rodrigo Duterte as Special Assistant to the President, with the rank of Secretary, from June 30, 2016 to October 15, 2018. He resigned as Duterte’s top aide to run for the 2019 senatorial election. Having earned Duterte’s trust and confidence, Senator Go cemented his position as the “People’s Bridge to the President”—someone who can ensure the public’s concerns and needs reach the attention of the Chief Executive.

FINAL KEYNOTE ADDRESS: President Rodrigo Duterte was elected mayor of Davao in 1988 and has not lost an election since. Duterte won a landslide victory as the 16th President of the Philippines, with 16.6 million votes, the highest number of votes won by any Philippine president before him. He is the first President from Mindanao, and the first local chief executive to get elected straight to the Office of the President.
